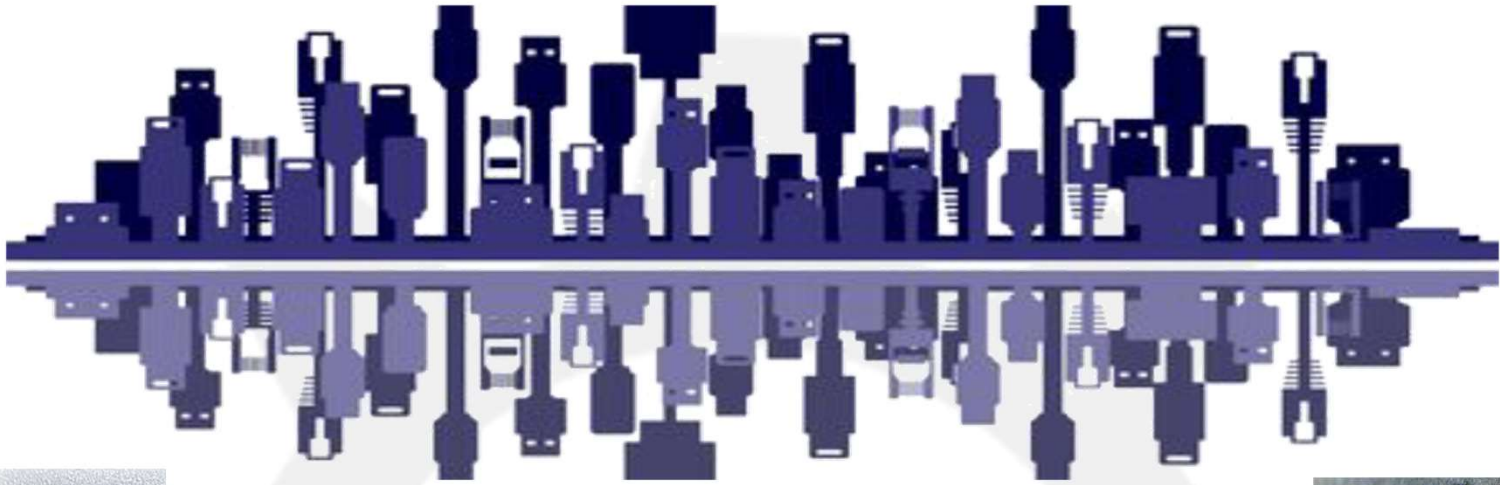


Plugs Leads



So what are all of those 'strange' computer/phone plugs?



- **REMEMBER: Kevin's Law: Plug the smallest one in FIRST!**
Power adapter in last.. No FIZZ
- **No BUMBLE FINGERS** - Always plug in / take out squarely: no bending/twisting or you may break your device
Always check if the plug is the correct way up. **DO NOT FORCE**



➤ Your device has a number of sockets to plug stuff in... but be careful as today there are a number of similar plugs that may not fit your socket.

Laptop Confused

- 1: USB A
- 2: Display Port
- 3: HDMI

Phone Confused

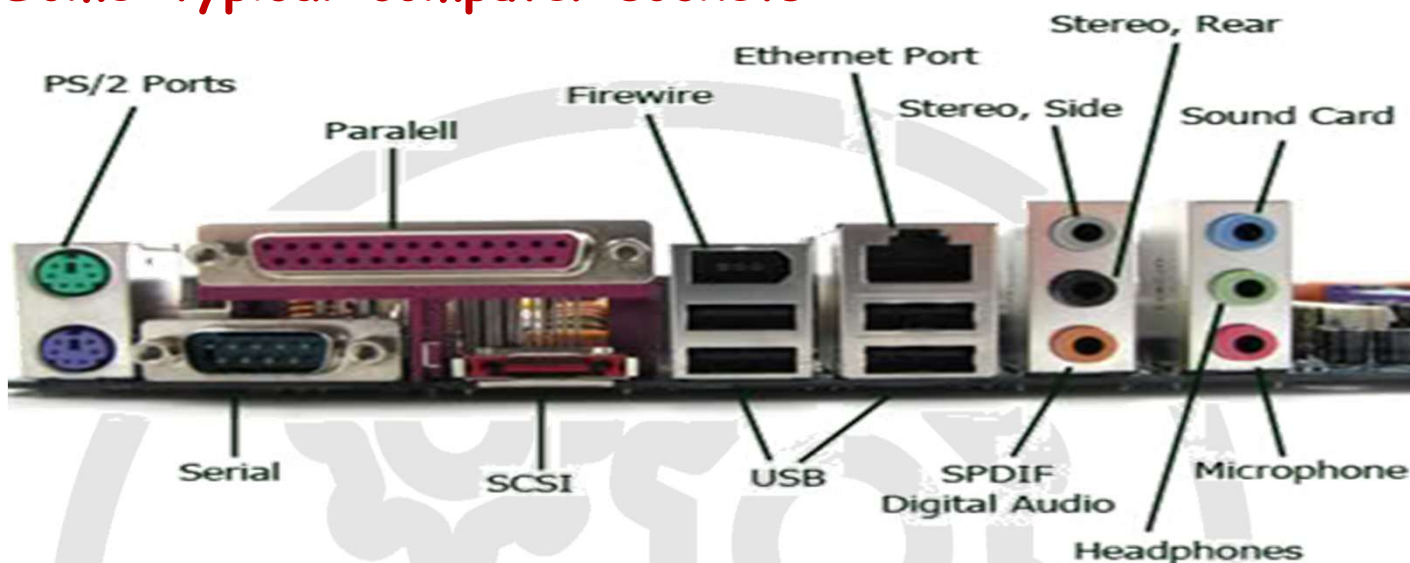
- 1: Thunderbolt
- 2: Lightning
- 3: USB Mini A
- 4: USB Mini B
- 3: USB 'C'

Labels for connectors: USB PORT, USB MINI B, USB MICRO B, USB MINI A, USB TYPE C, HDMI, DISPLAY PORT, THUNDERBOLT, LIGHTNING, ETHERNET, and audio jacks.



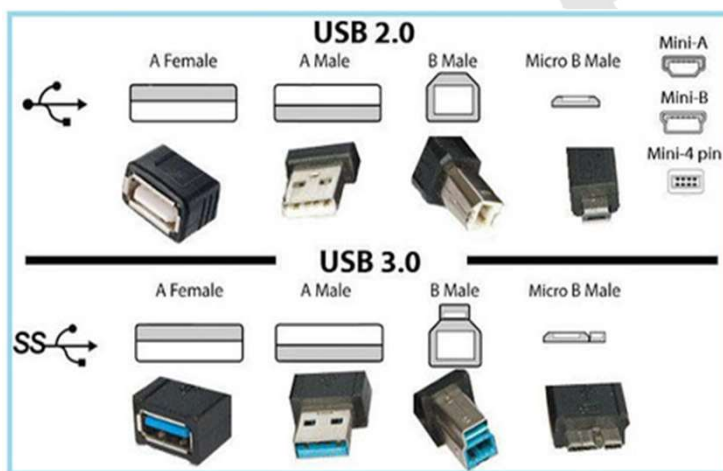
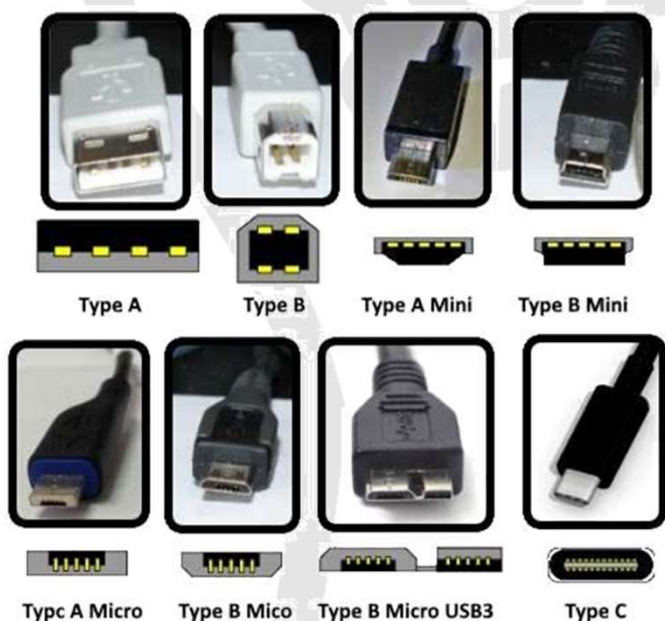


Some 'typical' computer sockets -



The 'Universal Serial Bus (USB)' is used on most laptops to connect peripherals: Mouse, Keyboard, Disk Drive, CD, etc. but it has lots of different 'Flavours'

Even 'plain' USB are confusing as there are two standards USB 2 and 3 that can charge at different rates
