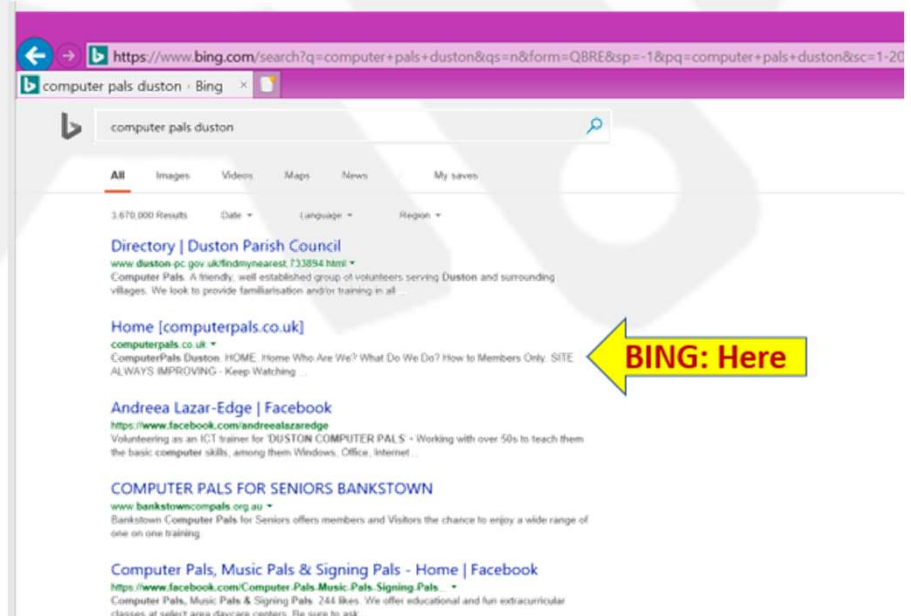

### One Click 'logon' to ComputerPals Website

1. Right mouse click on the Desktop

3. In the 'Create Shortcut' box

4. Enter "www.ComputerPals.co.uk"

6. Enter "ComputerPals"

7. Click 'Finish'
