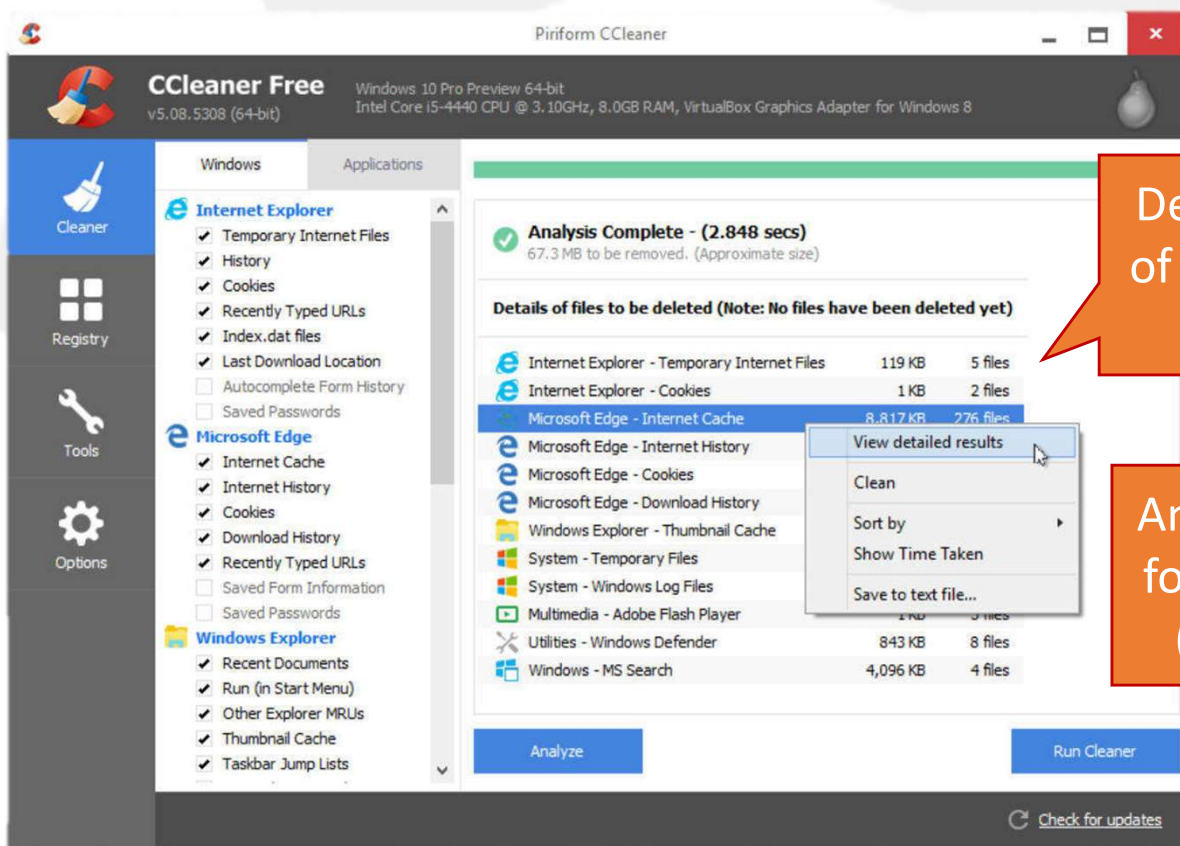


## 9: How to ensure your laptop stays in good working order eg using CCleaner

### CCleaner

Its a cleanup software tool that speeds up your PC and improves its performance.



Deletes loads of 'unwanted' files

You can use CCleaner to remove junk files from your hard drives, such as unwanted browser addons, software products that you never use, or duplicate files that take up all the space. It's also possible to clean the system registry. The system registry is a database with the information about the settings and configurations of your computer and the operating system (Windows).

**CCleaner** (originally Crap Cleaner), developed by Piriform Software, is a utility used to clean potentially unwanted files and invalid Windows Registry entries from a computer. It is one of the longest-established system cleaners, first launched in 2004. It was originally developed for Microsoft Windows only, but in 2012, a macOS version was released. An Android version was released in 2014.


### CCleaner Free
